

Did You Know That an Industrial Scale Mill Is Proposed for Your Neighbourhood?

- An industrial scale mill has been proposed on rural lands just outside the Village of Goodwood, at 351 Regional Road 47, Goodwood.
- The grain processing mill will have 18 silos and about an acre of factory space and offices, and it will operate 18 hours a day.
- Uxbridge Town Council will vote on the proposal before the end of January 2019.

Are you comfortable with more noise and dust, and with more trucks passing through Goodwood?

If this worries you, you need to act now to demand that Uxbridge Town Council delay its upcoming vote so the residents of Goodwood can learn exactly what is proposed.

There is very little time to act!

Concerned residents of Goodwood are demanding that the company proposing the mill, Grain Boys Holdings Inc., be required to hold a public meeting at Goodwood Community Centre with a full formal presentation on the proposed mill.

Sample Letter to Uxbridge Town Council

Copy this sample letter or much better yet write a letter in your own words. Make sure to do this right away. We have very little time before Council votes on the Grain Boys mill proposal. Even if you are not sure about the project and you just want to know more, you should write to demand a full presentation.

To Mayor and Council

I want to register as a citizen of Goodwood my vote against the Grain Boys Holdings Inc. development east of Goodwood at 351 Regional Road 47.

I am also requesting that Council not make a decision on the Grain Boys development until such time as we have had a formal presentation from the owners of Grain Boys at the Goodwood Community Centre.

With the many discrepancies at the meeting of January 7 at the Goodwood Community Centre with the representatives of Grain Boys we the citizens feel this development is a moving target as a result of the many changes in the written material and expressed verbally at the meeting.

We the residents also request a recorded vote be held at council for the above requests from the residents.

Our requests are:

- 1. A formal presentation by the Grain Boys Holdings Inc. representatives.
- 2. No decision made by Council until we have had a formal presentation and our questions are answered.
- 3. A recorded vote for both decisions for the record.

We would also appreciate being notified when these requests are on the agenda for voting.
